You are cordially invited to participate in the Ickesburg Bi-Centennial Parade, Saturday, July 28th, forming by 11:00 am. On the outskirts of Ickesburg.

This special event marks 200th anniversary of the beginnings of Saville Township and the village of Ickesburg, in north western Perry County, Pennsylvania, this historic undertaking is being planned by the township, and the Ickesburg Fire Company, whose annual carnival coincides with the weeklong events, July 24th – 29th.

“Days Gone By” is the parade theme. Entrants are encouraged to reflect on the history of the past 200 years in their presentations. Prizes are to be awarded in 19 categories.

Of special interest to participants, will be the AVTT, American Veterans Traveling Tribute, Vietnam Memorial Wall replica, where they can search for the names of family and friends who perished in that war. Commemorative services are planned for each evening starting July 26th, when the wall will be open for viewing.

A museum of local artifacts, and history will be open to the public. And, the carnival grounds will be boasting a large array of foods, including homemade ice cream and Ickesburg Fire Company’s famous French fries. Olde’ Time Games, auctions, and live entertainment will round out the day’s events.
