

**SAVILLE TOWNSHIP**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2000- 3**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SAVILLE, PERRY COUNTY, ESTABLISHING REGULATING TRAFFIC UPON CERTAIN TOWNSHIP ROADS; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Saville, a municipal corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, being situate in the County of Perry of said Commonwealth, as follows:

**PART I**

**GENERAL REGULATIONS**

**Section 1: Short Title**

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as "2000 Vehicle Traffic Regulation Ordinance of the Township of Saville".

**Section 2: Enactment**

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority conferred by the "Vehicle Code", Act of 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, No. 81 Section 1, effective July 1, 1977; 75

Pa.C.S.A. § 101, et seq., as amended, and by The Second Class Township Code, Act of 1933, May 1, P.L. 103 § 101; 53 P.S. 65101, et seq., as amended.

**Section 3: Definitions and Interpretation**

1. Words and phrases, when used in this Chapter, except for sections or Parts to which different or additional definitions apply, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in The Vehicle Code (the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162 No. 81), as amended, except that, in this Chapter, the words "street and road" may be used interchangeably with the word "highway", and shall have the same meaning as the word "highway" as defined in the Vehicle Code.

2. In this Chapter, the singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular, and the masculine shall include the feminine.

**Section 4: Provisions to be Continuation of Existing Regulations**

The provisions of this Chapter, so far as they are the same as those of ordinances and regulations in force immediately before the enactment of this Chapter, are intended as a continuation of those earlier ordinances and regulations, and not as new enactments. Nothing in this Chapter shall affect any act done or liability incurred, or any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted under any of those repealed or superseded ordinances or regulations.

### **Section 5: Authority of Police Officers**

Police Officers of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, commonly referred to as the Pennsylvania State Police, and any Township Police Officer are hereby given authority to regulate traffic on the highways of Saville Township.

### **Section 6: Signs**

All signs and signals required under any of the sections of this Ordinance, or amendments thereto, shall be procured and erected, posted and maintained so as to give proper effect to this Ordinance and to comply with applicable law.

### **Section 7: Repealer**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following ordinances or parts thereof are specifically repealed: None.

### **Section 8: Severability**

If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Chapter is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Chapter. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Governing Body that this Chapter would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

**Section 9: Effective Date**

This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment thereof.

**PART II**

**TRAFFIC REGULATIONS**

**Section 1: Stop Intersections Established**

1. The following intersections are established as stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected in such a position as to face traffic approaching the through road on the first named road in the direction or directions indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first named or stop road, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the second named intersection or through road until the driver has followed all applicable requests of that Section of law:

<u>Stop Street</u>	<u>Intersection or Through Street</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>
T-429 (Honeysuckle Hollow Road)	T-354 (Eschol Ridge Road)	East/West
T-354 (Eschol Ridge Road)	T-429 (Honeysuckle Hollow Road)	North/South

**Section 2: Penalties for Violation**

Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code as it pertains to fines and other penalties.

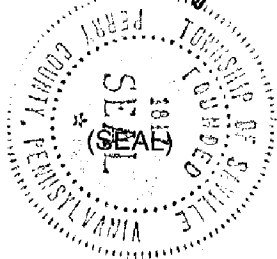
