

SAVILLE TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE NO. 3-88

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SAVILLE, PERRY COUNTY,
ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS UPON CERTAIN TOWNSHIP
ROADS; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved, by the Board of
Supervisors of the Township of Saville, a municipal corporation of
the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, being situate in the County of
Perry of said Commonwealth, as follows:

Part 1

General Regulations

Section 1: Short Title

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as "Motor
Vehicle Maximum Speed Limitation Ordinance of the Township of
Saville".

Section 2: Enactment

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority conferred
by the "Vehicle Code", Act of 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, No. 81
Section 1, effective July 1, 1977; 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 101, et seq., as
amended, and by The Second Class Township Code, Act of 1933, May 1,
P.L. 103 § 101; 53 P.S. 65101, et seq., as amended.

Section 3: Definitions and Interpretation

1. Words and phrases, when used in this Chapter, except for
sections of Parts to which different or additional definitions

apply, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in The Vehicle code (the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162 No. 81), as amended, except that, in this Chapter, the words "street and road" may be used interchangeably with the word "highway, and shall have the same meaning as the word "highway" as defined in the Vehicle Code.

2. In this chapter, the singular shall be include the plural, the plural shall include the singular, and the masculine shall include the feminine.

Section 4: Provisions to be Continuation of
Existing Regulations

The provisions of this Chapter, so far as they are the same as those of ordinances and regulations in force immediately before the enactment of this Chapter, are intended as a continuation of those earlier ordinances and regulations, and not as new enactments. Nothing in this Chapter shall affect any act done or liability incurred, or any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted under any of those repealed or superseded ordinances or regulations.

Section 5: Authority of Police Officers

Police Officers of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, commonly referred to as the Pennsylvania State Police, and any Township Police Officer are hereby given authority to regulate speed on the highways of Saville Township.

Section 6: Authorization to Use Speed Timing Devices

The Pennsylvania State Police and/or any designated Township employee are hereby authorized to use all speed timing devices for the determination of speed of a motor vehicle as are approved or will be approved by the Department of Transportation of the

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in accordance with Title 75, Pa.C.S.A § 3368.

This section authorizes the use of said devices upon all highways within Saville Township, be they township, county or state highways, and does also hereby elect to exercise all powers granted to "local authorities" under the Vehicles Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, 75 Pa.C.S.A. §§ 6101, et seq. (1977) as hereafter amended, supplemented, modified or reenacted by the General Assembly of Pennsylvania.

Section 7: Signs

All signs and signals required under any of the sections of this Ordinance, or amendments thereto, shall be procured and erected, posted and maintained so as to give proper effect to this Ordinance and to comply with applicable law.

Section 8: Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following ordinances or parts thereof are specifically repealed:

Section 9: Severability

If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Chapter is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Chapter. It is hereby declared as the intent of the [Governing Body] that this chapter would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 10: Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment thereof.

Part 2

Traffic Regulations

Section 1: Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets

1. Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, highways and roads, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
1. Twp. Route #356 (Jackson Hollow Rd. and Foose Ridge Rd.)	From Spring Twp. line to State Legislative Route 50002	35 miles per hour
2. Twp. Route #348 (Peach Ridge Road)	From Spring Twp. line to Route 849	35 miles per hour
3. Twp. Route #350 (Peach Ridge Road)	From Twp. Route 348 to Legislative Route 50002	35 miles per hour
4. Twp. Route 421 (Pleasant Valley Road)	From Centre Twp. line to PA Route 74	45 miles per hour

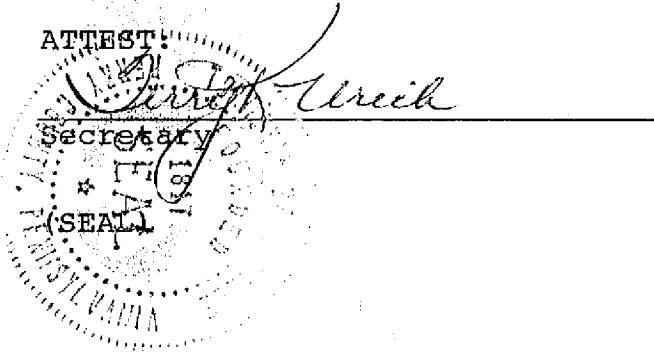
Section 2: Penalties for Violation

Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code as it pertains to fines and other penalties.
