

Saville Township Meeting Minutes

The Meeting was called to order by Mark McNaughton, followed by all attendees standing to say the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call

Public Comment

Joseph Brubaker is the owner of the proposed chicken house at 211 Red Bud Lane, Loysville. He wanted to make sure we have the plans. Plans are here at the township building and the Planning Commission will be reviewing them on 9/15/25.

A Treasurers Report was reviewed for the General Fund, Streetlight Fund and Liquid Fuels. Colton Bear made a motion to accept the financial reports as given. Grady Reisinger 2nd. The Motion carried.

The Planning Committee Report - 8/18/25 meeting

- Attendees included: Grady Reisinger, John Sauder and Mel Weaver, Stanley Urich, Ben Kirk, Joseph Brubaker and Curfman & Zullinger Surveying
- The committee signed off on the McAllister Plan
- The committee did not sign off on the Menges/Hall/Calvin Subdivision as they had not reviewed the Perry County Planning Committee remarks. (The county comments were in the file). The plan will be reviewed at the 9/15/25 meeting.
- The committee looked at the Joseph Brubaker Poultry Farm Plan – no comments
- The committee talked with Stanley Urich about a right of way
- Cory Peterson was not present to speak about Mountain Supply project.
- The meeting adjourned at 9:15 PM

The Board Chairman and Secretary signed the McAllister Plans. Wyatt Lowe took it with him when he left.

Consent Agenda Items

- Approval of minutes from August – Colton Bear made the motion to accept the meeting minutes, Grady Reisinger 2nd. All Supervisors were in favor – motion carried.
- Bill List and Correspondence - Colton Bear made the motion to accept these , Grady Reisinger 2nd. All Supervisors were in favor – motion carried.

Old Business

It was reported that a 2009 JD 410J Backhoe was purchased for \$32,000.00. It was purchased from Leon Equipment, 1080 Elliot St., Harrisburg, PA 17104. It is currently being serviced and will soon be delivered to the township building.

Colton Bear has made inquiries regarding a Leaf Blower. He is waiting on a requote after September 1, 2025.

Lori McNaughton gave an update on the progress of the website. She will soon be trained to be able to maintain the website. It was hoped to launch the site in the 4th quarter.

Colton Bear was at 126 Walton Circle, but did not speak to anyone. He did not think there were any bad smells or see any rodents, but it still is a mess and needs attention. Colton will continue to monitor the situation.

Our insurance agent confirmed that there is liability coverage if a piece of equipment happens to hit an underground utility line.

New Business

The Board of Supervisors approved and signed Resolution 2025-6 – Hazard Mitigation Plan . FEMA has approved the Perry County Hazard Mitigation Plan. Municipalities and townships who sign its resolution will fall under the county mitigation plan. Colton Bear made a motion to approve this Resolution, Grady Reisinger 2nd. All were in favor and the motion carried.

The Board of Supervisors approved opening a new CD with Pennian Bank with \$200,000 from the State Liquid Fuels account #6613194. This CD would be for a term of 5 months. The Secretary will contact Pennian Bank and take the necessary steps to open this new 5 month CD. Colton Bear made a motion to approve opening a new CD, Mark McNaughton 2nd. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Vehicle inspections of the 4 trucks come due in October, November, December and January. The idea was mentioned to get all 4 trucks done as soon as legally possible and not wait for the exact month. Mark McNaughton will contact Hoover Bros about the inspections.

The Board of Supervisors held an Executive Meeting at 6:15 PM – 6:30 PM prior to the township meeting to discuss adding Jebadiah Reisinger as an employee for the cleaning, mowing, and any other work he might do for the township. Colton Bear made a motion to accept this new hire, Grady Reisinger 2nd. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Discussion occurred regarding looking for a different solicitor who may be more aggressive with chasing down the unpaid sewer bills. The Secretary had prepared a spreadsheet with possible solicitors who may be possibilities. It was agreed to have a meeting scheduled with David Wilson from Philpott and Wilson from Duncannon.

Robby Rohm and Mike Alleman have been very diligent in doing road work over the past few weeks. Work included the following:

- Patching potholes
- Road mowing has been done twice – working on the 3rd time
- Cleaned up in the back of the township building
- All road signs are in place with road/sign maps showing where signs are along the roads.
- Ditch cleanng
- It is noted that many culverts needs cleared yet.

Robby Rohm will be on vacation for several weeks, but Mike Alleman will finish the mowing and work on road patching.
